



Anglesea Bike Park Committee of Management

The Anglesea Bike Park facility is managed by the Anglesea Bike Park Committee of Management with membership from the local community, user groups and also with representation from the Surf Coast Shire and Alcoa. The committee organises regular working bees to maintain the facilities and welcomes anybody wanting to lend a hand.

Meetings - The Anglesea Bike Park Committee of Management have a bi-monthly meeting at the Anglesea Community House (at 7.00 p.m. on the last Thursday of February, April, June, August and October). The October Meeting is generally the AGM. Anyone is welcome to attend these meetings.

Wet Weather Policy

Wet Weather Policy – the Anglesea Bike Park will be closed when raining or when heavy rain is forecast and will re-open when the track is dry. Damage can be done to the track surface if used in wet conditions.

Group Bookings

Group Booking Policy – To enable the provision of a sustainable facility to a excellent standard, an annual group usage fee was introduced in 2008. This fee is \$200 (inclusive of GST) and applies to all organised groups who use the Anglesea Bike Park and charge their participants (profit or non-profit groups) as part of a bicycle program.

The annual fee allows groups to use the bike park on a Monday to Friday between the hours of 10 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. Exclusive usage for up to 2 hours is permitted during the above times. Bookings must be made in advance to ensure availability.

THE ANGLESEA BIKE PARK has evolved through a great partnership between the Anglesea community (now represented by the Anglesea Bike Park

2006) caters for all skill levels with riders encouraged to ride within their own ability on the Mountain Cross (4 X) track or on the more technical Jump Trail course. USERS CODE OF CONDUCT

- > Take pride in sharing this facility with others of varying ability

- > Do not take short cuts or make changes to the track at any time
- > Do not stop, stand or walk on the track at any time
- > Please stay on the formed tracks and clean your bike to prevent the spread of Cinnamon Fungus to natural areas
- > Take your rubbish home with you
- > Trail Bikes are not permitted to use this facility
- > Groups are required to book this facility prior to use, please contact the Surf Coast Shire on 5261 0800 or the Anglesea Bike Park COM on www.angleseabikepark.org

WARNING:



Tracks contain difficult technical features! Mountain Bike riding is hazardous. Riders use the area at their own risk.

ALWAYS:

- > Ride in one direction only
- > Respect the rights of other riders
- > Wear a helmet and protective gear

- > Do not use this facility if affected by drugs or alcohol
